Terms and Conditions

I. Rates:

- A. Rates are \$295 per hour after the first 20 minutes (will be prorated)
- B. All jobs will be performed as scheduling allows
- C. This rate is for a 3-man crew.

II. Approved sites:

- A. Will be grouped by location
- B. Will be chipped at the same time as other sites in the area are chipped

III. Materials Guidelines:

Accepted materials include trees, logs and branches less than 6 inches in diameter, free of nails and wire. The following restrictions apply:

A. No construction or building materials

- B. No treated lumber, fence posts or signs
- C. No shrubs, root wads, stumps, dirt or rocks
- D. No poison oak, oleanders or blackberries
- E. No grass clippings, trash, weeds or bags of leaves, no thorns , palm fronds, poison oak or oleander
- F. No bulldozed piles

III. Pile Guidelines:

- A. Stack piles neatly (no bags) perpendicular to the road
- B. Large ends facing the road, stacked parallel.
- C. Piles not higher than four feet.
- D. Place piles within 5 feet of the roadway but not touching the road or in drainage ditches.
- E. Pile should be ready for chipping on the Sunday following the application deadline
